The charges and commissions are used to cover the Fund's operating costs, including marketing and distribution of units. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.

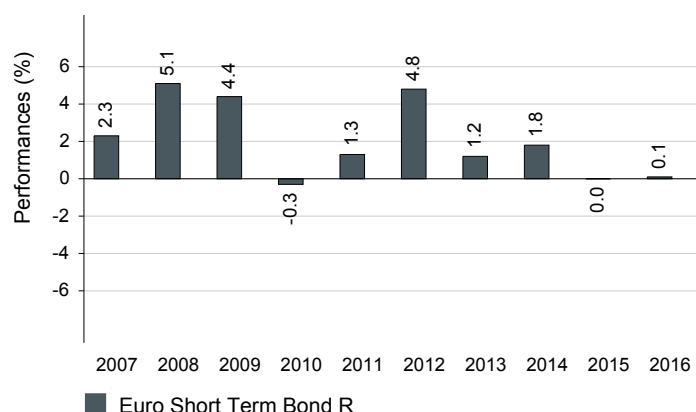
