### **COOKIE'S POLICY**

The software applications used by this Website may contain the so called "cookie" technology. Cookies mainly aim to facilitate User's navigation. Cookies may provide information on Users' navigation on the Website and allow the operation of certain services that require identification of the Users' journey through different pages of the Website. Any access to the Website, regardless of the presence of a cookie, the type of browser and the operating system (eg Microsoft, Apple, Android, Linux, etc ...) the Host and the URL of origin of the visitor, is registered. Users might set up their browser in order to be informed when a cookie is received and decide whether to delete it or not (for further information please see paragraph 3 below).

# 1. What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files containing data, created by the visited website, that contain data. They are stored in Users' computer to give them access to various functions. Cookies allow the Website to keep Users' informations and to analyze how they deal with the Website.

Cookies are safe for Users' devices, they can only store informations related to browser access or those which are included in the requested page. Cookies cannot be transformed into codes and cannot be used to access Users' computers. Where the informations on a website are encrypted in a cookie, only the website itself can read such informations. # 2. Types of cookies used and for what purposes

This Website uses technical cookies, which allow User to navigate on the Website. For example, through traffic control and data communication it is possible to identify the session and use the security features during navigation. These cookies are not used for further purposes and are usually installed by the Website master. Technical cookies are used for the following purposes:

# 3. How Users can disabling Cookies

Most of browsers automatically accept cookies, but Users can choose not to allow it. Users who are not accepting the use of cookies can modify the security settings of their own browser (Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, etc.).

Here is a list of the various procedures for disabling cookies according to the most commonly-used browsers. For cookie settings involving browsers not included in the list, Users will need to refer to help documentation set out by the relevant browser producer.

### **Microsoft Internet Explorer**

Click on "Tools" in the menu bar and select "Internet Options"

Click on the "Privacy" tab in the top part

Drag the scroll down device until you reach "Block all cookies"

### **Google Chrome**

Click on the "Chrome Menu" in the browser tool bar. Select "Settings"

Click on "Under the Hood" In the Privacy section, click on "Content settings".

In the "Cookie" section, select "Ignore exceptions and block third party cookie settings".

Select "Options"

Click on the "Privacy" tab

Select the box "Tell the website I do not want to be tracked"
